

RESOLUTION NO. 22 -

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENICIA
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF REPLACEMENT IN-CAR CAMERAS FOR
SIXTEEN (16) POLICE PATROL VEHICLES AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO SIGN THE PURCHASE ORDER**

WHEREAS, the replacement of in-car cameras for twelve (12) police vehicles is needed due to failing systems and outdated technology purchased in 2015; and

WHEREAS, four (4) additional in-car cameras are needed for the School Resource Officer and Community Service Officers vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Axon Fleet 3 in-car cameras will be purchased through Axon in an amount not-to-exceed \$164,920.16 over the next five years; and

WHEREAS, the amount for the FY 2022/23 contract payment of approximately \$33,000 is budgeted within the Equipment Replacement Fund (Org/Object) 6355000-7008; and

WHEREAS, the purchase is made through the sole source process since Axon Enterprises is the only manufacturer and sole distributor and retailer for TASER brand products and Axon brand cameras, which the Department utilizes; and

WHEREAS, Axon Fleet 3 in-car camera is the only system that can integrate with our current weapon systems, camera systems, and digital storage system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Benicia approves the purchase of 16 in-car cameras from Axon Enterprise for an amount not-to-exceed \$164,920.16 over the next 5 years and authorizes the City Manager to sign the purchase orders on behalf of the City.
